Marketing/Advertising: signs (create & arrange for printing), newspaper articles (write and send to papers), flyers (create & arrange for distribution), radio (provide info to stations for PSAs)

Donations: assist with collecting of food, money and pledge cards (this is day of event)

Food: securing potential food vendors (calling to solicit potential vendors)

Vendors: securing community service/non-profit vendors that can assist those in need (calling to solicit)

Raffles/Silent Auction: securing items to be raffled/sold during the event; handing out raffle tickets, setting up and staffing silent auction tables, collecting money for items purchased during auction

Storytelling/dramatic reader: We'll have a featured storyteller, but will need others to help tell or read the stories of how God cares for the poor, hungry or foreigner (Ginger will head this team)

Budget: assist in securing grants or donations to help off-set expenses

We are currently meeting each Wednesday evening at 6:30 p.m. Please join us to learn more and get your team started.
