### The Season of Lent

As we journey through this season, I'd like to share with you a few of the many descriptions of Lent that I've encountered:

- A season of sorrowful reflection; a season of grief.
- A time of simplicity and solemnity. A time to reflect on our dependence on God's mercy and our understanding of faith.
- Lent Is preparing good things for us just as eternal life was being prepared for us in Jesus' ending ministry.
- A time to review the times when God extricated us from trouble.
- A time to remember the
- goodness of Jesus.
- A time of prayer and meditation.

Any prayer, as long as it means something to you, is a step in the direction God intended. If you have a favorite prayer that speaks to you, take some time to focus on what it truly means and see if you can incorporate that prayer into your everyday life. In addition to prayer, there are many Lenten meditations. A good one about the work, ministry and passion of Jesus can be found in the gospel of Luke.

Here at FPCD, one of the ways we are journeying through Lent this year is with our Wednesday evening suppers at 6 p.m. followed by two different studies from 6:30 p.m. to 7:15 p.m. We hope you will join us if you haven't already done so. Listen, too, to this poem about Lent. It was written by Ann Weems (1934-2016), the daughter of a Presbyterian minister, who was a noted writer, speaker, liturgist and worship leader. This poem comes from *Kneeling in Jerusalem*, her book of poetry about Lent and Easter.

"Lent is a time to take the time to let the power of our faith story take hold of us,

- a time to let the events get up and walk around in us,
- a time to intensify
- our living unto Christ, a time to hover over
- the thoughts of our hearts,
- a time to place our feet in the streets of Jerusalem
  - or to walk along the sea and
  - listen to his word,
- a time to touch his robe
- and feel the healing surge through us,

a time to ponder and a time to wonder...

Lent is a time to allow a fresh new taste of God!"
