
The Things Worth Thinking About

The Schaefers have recently returned to the USA for a time of furlough. They are making their home on a family farm in Missouri. After being in Ghana for the last 2 1/2 years, they found that their house needs some work, so they are busy cleaning, installing storm windows, cutting a supply of wood and making needed repairs before winter begins with snow and cold temperatures. The children will register in the local public schools in January for the second semester of the year. When not helping around the farm, they are finishing home schooling assignments to prepare for their new school environment.


Back in Ghana their colleagues are continuing to do an exegetical check of Matthew (now up to chapter 22). They send their work to Paul who goes over their draft, makes corrections and sends them back to the group who meets every week to carry on the work. Teachers in the area are using the Safaliba books and curriculum that they worked on with Paul before his leaving for furlough. They are also continuing to write and print books for the school's use that Paul will edit and format. They are thankful for digital technology that helps make this work possible over the long distance.

They really appreciate your prayers for them and the work, mentioning:

New Beginners Grief Support Meeting


