Mission News

Gary and Linda Simons are missionaries with Wycliffe Bible Translators and work in Dallas at the Summer Institute of Linguistics (SIL International). They live near the International Linguistics Center--so close, in fact, they can walk to work each day. Gary's position at SIL is Chief Research Officer; he also serves as the Executive Editor for the Ethnologue (www.ethnologue.com), a comprehensive refer-



ence work cataloging all of the world's known living languages. It is widely regarded as the most comprehensive source of information of its kind. Linda works half-time as Gary's administrative assistant and also as the bibliographer for the Ethnologue.

In recent months Gary has traveled to Michigan as an invited speaker at an academic workshop planning an initiative to archive language documentation and to Maine to participate in a strategic planning workshop about SIL support for developing and publishing vernacular dictionaries. He had two tasks on a trip to Washington DC: to consult in a planning workshop for an SIL research project to study literacy programs across Africa and to confer with our counterparts at the Library of Congress concerning maintaining our respective parts of the international standard ISO-639 for language codes.

For fun, Gary reads audio books, watches football on TV, and follows Linda around on birdwatching expeditions. He also is very talented musically, playing the piano and composing music our choir has sung. Linda relaxes by trying to identify all the birds in the world (so far, she has 377 on her life list), blogging, and baking cakes (Not only are they delicious, but they are decorated so creatively they draw a crowd just to look at them).
