At this very special time of year, God's love is tangibly expressed so that we can see it most clearly. Let that expression of God's best gift (Jesus) motivate you to gratitude and trust. You are not going through a single day alone. There is nothing in your life that is too big for your loving heavenly Father and His faithful Messiah to handle. Prayer will change you. So get going! Unpack the best gift. It belongs to you.

Here is an excerpt from Pastor Ginger's update:



### Cook's Corner

### **Reindeer Cookies**

Just in time for the holidays, these cookies can also be made with other cookie recipes such as sugar cookie or gingerbread.



3/4 cup peanut butter
1 1/4 cup firmly packed brown
sugar
1/2 cup shortening
3 tablespoons milk
1 tablespoon vanilla
1 egg
1 3/4 cup all-purpose flour
3/4 teaspoon baking soda
3/4 teaspoon salt
Chocolate-covered (or plain)
mini pretzels
Mini brown M&Ms
Regular-size red M&Ms

Preheat oven to 375°F.

Combine brown sugar, peanut butter, shortening, milk, and vanilla in large bowl. Beat at medium speed until well blended. Add egg; beat until just blended.

In a separate bowl, combine flour, baking soda, and salt. Add to creamed mixture at low speed. Mix just until blended.

Form dough into 1-inch balls. Shape each ball into a reindeer face by first pinching the bottom of the ball slightly to form a point, then gently flatten with your hand. Grease the cookie sheet and space the cookies about 2 inches apart. Bake for 7 to 8 minutes, until set or just beginning to brown.

Remove cookies from the oven and immediately (and gently) press two mini pretzels into the tops of the cookies for the reindeer's antlers. Press two mini brown M&Ms in for the eyes and one red M&M for the nose (or any other color you choose).

Allow to cool 2 minutes on the baking sheet and then transfer to a wire rack or paper towel to cool completely.

Makes about 40 reindeer cookies.
