
We are indebted to God for this fabulous world in which to live, recognizing the great bounty we have received.






### Women's Bible Study Group

Hungry for Christmas cookies? Here's an easy recipe from the kitchen of Doris Metzger

### **FORGOTTEN COOKIES**

(A cookie that will use the egg whites from cookie press cookies. It can also add color to a cookie tray and gives you a chance to be creative with color, flavoring and additions of your own.)

2 egg whites 3/4 cup sugar pinch of salt 1/2 tsp. vanilla

1/2 tsp. cream of tartar 1 1/2 cup mini chocolate pieces or nuts (optional)

Preheat oven to moderately hot (375) for at least 15 minutes. Beat egg whites until frothy. Add salt and cream of tartar and beat until stiff. Add sugar, a tablespoon at a time, beating constantly. Beat until glossy. Add vanilla and chocolate pieces or nuts.

Drop on greased cookie sheets. Place in oven; turn off oven immediately. Let stand overnight. Do not open oven door for at least five hours after cookies go in.

Meringue can be tinted pink or green for the holidays. Mint flavoring can be substituted for vanilla for variety. Or different flavored chips can be used.
