# From Session– Dub Guthrie

The start of a new year is a good time to look back at what has occurred in the last year and look forward to the new year. I would like to look back a little further. I have been on Session six years out of the last seven. There have been some dramatic changes during that period.

When I came onto Session in January, 2007, the church's situation was not good. The expenses were exceeding income by about \$2,000 a month. We had enough money to last at most 2 more years. During the previous year we had lost several families. We considered yoking with the Desoto church to cut expenses. The congregation was against this with some even suggesting we go ahead and close the church. Shortly after that, the pastor was asked to resign. This was all in the first six months.

We then starting working to be sure the church survived. Presbytery furnished a minister to moderate Session meetings. We had different ministers fill the pulpit on Sundays. The Session members took the pastoral duties. After a few months we selected Ginger Hertenstein to serve as Stated Supply and moderate the Session. We didn't feel we could afford a full time pastor at that time. The optimism and enthusiasm of the congregation began to improve. About a year late we felt we were stable enough and could afford to hire a full time pastor. After a search and following the steps required by Presbytery, Ginger was selected to be pastor.

Since that time many positive things have occurred in the church. Our music has continued to be outstanding thanks to the 2 choir directors we have had and the talent of the choir members. We improved the tech portion of the services and have gone online. The youth group has grown and has impacted the lives of those who attend. Storytelling has been incorporated into the worship services. The last three years we have had a budget that bordered on being unrealistically optimistic. We have met them all and even reached the income portion of our budget by the end of November in 2013. We have had the Conversation with God series to help us to connect with God. We saw the miraculous recovery of Tristan Russell. In 2012, we had a live nativity that was well attended even having cars stop on the street to see what was happening. A new Sunday school class on the basics was started. Then came the Festival of Hope last October that through the hard work of the entire congregation we were able to raise over \$50,000 for Duncanville Outreach Ministry. This activity had a positive impact on the whole community.

When you compare the last paragraph with the situation in 2007, the contrast is amazing. The question now is what do we do next? The Session has been energized to be God's light to this community. As a result of the festival, a group of community leaders want to have a series of meetings to discuss ways to improve the Duncanville community. This is the work of the church and each of us individually, to reach into the community with God's hope. We will continue some of the successful activities of the previous years. To me the biggest challenge is growing the church, especially with younger members. Our present congregation has it largest age group between 60 and 80 years of age. It is obvious if we don't get younger we have a limited life span. We would ask you to pray for God's continued support, to give any suggestions for church growth, and to help us to work toward this goal.

We have come a long way, but in the church there is always more to do. We appreciate your help in the past and look forward to what God has in store for us in the future.
