## Easter News from your Pastor

During the past three months' study of James and the Conversation with God study of each person in "The Prodigal Son," I have learned something significant. Something has jumped out at me in blazing colors, bringing new richness to my faith. The Conversation with God approach is to simply *listen* and allow the Holy Spirit to speak. The approach is not to study so as to gain more knowledge, but to learn by discovery and conversation. As we each bring our life experience to the text and share what we "heard," incredible lessons come out of it and each person is enriched. We are all a vital part; we each have something to offer which, when withheld, handicaps the rest of us. Thus, the congregation limps when you are not involved.

Why would God want me involved,' you might ask? You belong. Both James and the story of the Prodigal have helped us understand that we are all sinners, and yet we are all loved by our Father. We all need to enter into fellowship together without embarrassment—no matter our problems—for we are all invited. We are all a part of the to Him. family of God. But no one will force you. It is a willing commitment.

James, the brother of Jesus, was


once terribly embarrassed by his preacher brother. He didn't believe in him. He wanted to tell him what to do. But after the resurrection, James so strongly believed in Jesus that he stepped up and put his all into growing in the faith. It paid off. His letter greatly helps us grow in wisdom so that we are able to handle life's curveballs and support one another in the truth when we need a steadying hand.

On the morning of the Resurrection, one of the most memorable statements outside the tomb was what the angels told the women, "He is going ahead of you to Galilee. Go tell his disciples he will see you there." Jesus would be there before them! Whenever you come here, whenever you attempt to be involved, you not only come with other believers, but Jesus is already here ahead of you, waiting for you. Do you share the excitement of those first believers? With fear and GREAT **joy** they ran to meet him. Faith happens in community. Jesus is here, waiting for you. The congregation limps when you are not

here. So now. it's Easter. HE IS RISEN! Run

As we approach April, we want to remember that Jesus died on the cross for our sins, and made it possible for us to enter the New Jerusalem.



#### **Irish Nachos**

Irish Nachos

Prep Time: 15 minutes Cook Time: 40 Minutes Serves: 6

**Ingredients:** 

3 large red skinned potatoes, scrubbed and sliced
1 yellow onion, diced
Several tomatoes, washed & diced or well drained canned diced
1 pound ground meat
Salt
Pepper
2 Tbsp olive oil
1 cup cheddar cheese
Pkg Taco seasoning

#### **Directions:**

- 1. In a pan or cookie sheet, line the sliced potatoes making sure to cover as much of the bottom of the pan as possible. Sprinkle with salt, pepper and drizzle with olive oil; bake at 350°for about 35 minutes (or until tender). Once baked remove from oven & set aside.
- 2. Cook meat using directions of taco seasoning mix package. Once cooked, transfer to top of potatoes, add onions and tomatoes and sprinkle with cheese
- 3. Put back into the oven for 7 minutes or until the cheese has melted.
