Recently a story was told to me about a church that had a visitor. During the church service that man stood up and predicted that an economic famine was coming upon the entire nation. Hearing this news, believers there decided that everyone would give as much as they could to provide help to another church in a nearby town who might be struggling.

The story impacted me because here was a church of people who were so outward-looking that they anticipated the needs of another church even before the difficulty hit. Some might say their act is naïve. However, it may not be as naïve as it sounds. It may be the movement of the Spirit.

Thinking back to last year, we planned a public event at Duncanville Shine Performance Hall for telling the story of Good Friday and we invited nine other churches to join us. We knew such events were expensive, but our elders decided not to concentrate on the cost. This new territory was important enough that funding took second place behind getting Jesus' story out in public together as "the Church." Thus, we proceeded to do whatever was necessary to put together an excellent choir, secure an orchestra, advertise, build a cross, and present the best rendering of the events of Good

Friday that we could organize. The cost was \$5,800.00.

About four weeks before the event, we received an unexpected check in the mail from a well-known foundation in Dallas which covered all but 12 percent of our expenses. We had not applied for this money nor advertised the need. Our Festivals of Hope had made us known. With joy, we covered the rest of the cost, believing in the importance of our own investment in this inaugural event of churches working together to tell God's story.

The elders and I believe God has rewarded our steps of faith again and again. And why wouldn't He? The story about that other church who had a visitor is from Acts 11. God let that congregation know, even before the famine, how important their giving was. So this blessed Easter season, please know that your giving has great purpose in the Kingdom of God, and God will rejoice over and use your gifts to not only bless you, but to bless others in unexpected and surprising ways. Happy Easter. He is risen!

Armelia Jimmerson whips up this tasty sugar-free delight she adapted from the original version. Both recipes are included below.

Mandarin Orange Cake - Sugar-Free

Cake

1 sugar-free yellow cake mix ³/₄ cup oil (or apple sauce)

2 eggs

1 (15-oz) can mandarin oranges sugar-free (Libby's Skinny Fruit with Splenda)

Mix all ingredients with mixer; pour into greased (9 x 13-inch) baking pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 35 minutes. Cool well; refrigerate. Once the cake is cold, put on topping.

Topping:

1 large can crushed pineapple with 100% fruit juice

1 (8-oz) sugar-free Cool Whip

1 small package instant sugar-free vanilla pudding

Mix pineapple and pudding mix until thick. Fold in Cool Whip. Spread on cooled cake; refrigerate cake. Serve cold.

Mandarin Orange Cake

(original recipe)

Cake

1 butter (or yellow) cake mix ³/₄ cup oil (or apple sauce)

2 eggs

1 (15-oz) can mandarin oranges

Mix all ingredients with mixer; pour into greased (9 x 13-inch) baking pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 35 minutes.

Topping:

1 large can crushed pineapple with juice

1 (8-oz) Cool Whip

1 small package instant vanilla pudding
