# News from your Session

An exercise many of us go through is sorting through receipts. Whether you did it last month for vour tax return, an expense account at work or maybe you're just that good with your monthly budget, one thing you may have noticed about receipts is that over time some of them fade out illegible. and become This fading may have something to do with the techniques new in computerized printing where the main purpose isn't necessarily endurance, but rather speed. Anyway, whatever payment of an incurred debt that the receipts might represent is lost and you would have a difficult time trying to convince the I. R. S. or anyone else that they are anything more than meaningless pieces of paper.

There is one receipt, however that will never fade. It may not mean a hill of beans to the I.R.S. or your employer, but to us it means everything. For it states that our debts have been paid in full and. . . as Peter puts it. . . the promise that it represents is: .imperishable, undefiled, and unfading. . ." You know the receipt I'm talking about . . . it is the cross of Jesus Christ.

It may be important to keep all your receipts for tax time, but for Christ's sake . . . hang on to this one for dear life.

# **Stahls' Grand Stories**

#### Dear Friends,

#### April 14, 2015

Stories Illuminate Stories! We found out how excitingly true this statement is when we agreed to train a group of refugees who came to Dallas after being driven from their homeland by the land-grabbing government. Their personal stories of fleeing amid gunfire and bombs, and wandering in and out of refugee camps, without much food and inadequate clothing were painful to hear. We helped them to tell the story of Jonah in their own language, and in the

process Jim and I experienced Jonah's story in a new and powerful way. The huge fish faded into the background as the team practiced telling Jonah with all the emotion of not wanting to face their own oppressors. They sang laments similar to Jonah's in Chapter 2. And when we discussed how Jonah must have felt when God sent him to give a warning to Israel's hated oppressors, each of the team members confessed that they, like Jonah, would have run from God. They expressed their own fear at the thought of facing their violent enemies, and anger at the idea that God cared for their hated oppressors.



Their stories brought to my mind the people in my life that I don't pray for, and

whom I dismiss quickly from my mind because I consider them to be beyond God's love and grace. My stories pale in comparison to what these refugees endured at the hands of their enemies. What really impressed me, was that learning to tell this story of Jonah was not a deal-breaker for these people. They seemed to have no illusions that God would only command them to do what was easy and comfortable for them. Instead, they stood before the large group in the workshop with all sorts of visible and invisible scars, and were quick to remember the blessings they received from God. I will never read or hear Jonah's story the same again thanks to our new friends.

This week's mouth-watering contribution comes to us from Marna Bayless.

## **Quick Italian Spinach Pie**

16 ounces 2% Cottage Cheese

1 package (10 ounces) frozen, chopped spinach, thawed, well-drained 1 cup shredded low-moisture part-skim Mozzarella Cheese 4 eggs, beaten

1 jar (7 ounces) Roasted Red Peppers, well-drained, chopped 1/3 cup 100% Grated Parmesan Cheese

1 teaspoon dried Oregano leaves

Mix all ingredients.
Pour into greased 9-inch pie plate.
Bake at 350° for 40 minutes or until center is set. Makes 8 servings
Prep: 10 minutes
Bake: 40 minutes
Variation: Prepare as directed, substituting ½ cup chopped red pepper for roasted red pepper.




