It Starts With an Idea

A few months ago, I saw a cartoon on Facebook. A group of people, labeled as a pastor nominating committee, were sitting around a table. The caption said, "We agree that we want an innovative young pastor, full of fresh ideas, who will inspire us to stay just like we are." While some of us may have chuckled at this, unfortunately it is often too true but unspoken. It feels comfortable to go to church and know everyone, know the order of worship, and know all the hymns. Is our goal to be comfortable? Is that God's goal for us? Should we stay with a traditional style of worship if we know that it will not attract younger people? Maybe we need to consider making ourselves uncomfortable in order to attract a younger group of worshipers. There is nothing wrong with changing the style as long as we keep the same message.

Over the last few years, we have tried some new things that have showed we are willing to change. All these things started with an idea that was shared. Someone thought of having a fall festival and later taking that festival out into the community. That has resulted in our church being known in the community for working to better the community. We have raised over \$230,000 for Duncanville Outreach Ministry. It started with an idea.

Someone came up with the idea of having a youth service on the fourth Sunday. We have seen these become a

way for our youth to express their faith and show what an important part of our church they are.

Last year someone had the idea of a summer bash. It started as a fun day for all ages of young people. It resulted in a younger group meeting weekly on Wednesday evenings to study about God.


