
Worth the Price

Cook's Corner

Pineapple Angel Food Cake

1 (16 ounce) package angel food cake mix

1 (20 ounce) can crushed pineapple with juice

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray a 9x13 inch pan with vegetable oil spray.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine cake mix and pineapple (with juice). Mix until well blended.
- 3. Pour batter into prepared pan.
- 4. Bake for 25minutes or until golden brown. Let cool.

Can be served with whipped topping.

As with any Angel Food Cake, this is difficult to cut.


