As God's own people, we are to become united, learn to walk by faith so as not to be deceived by things that are not true. We are to speak the truth in love to others, and build others up in love. While we go about ministering for God, we become mature ourselves. It's the process—the doing—that brings maturity.

Now if we think this ministry of outreach is ONLY for each other in the church we are badly mistaken. These gifts are meant to flow OUT of the church to the community around us. Thus over the past ten years, we have a history of public ministry; public storytelling; public worship through music; public generosity to the poor;

public prayer in public places like the schools, the city government, business organizations, altruistic organizations, and with friends and neighbors.

Do you realize how many times we are asked to lead public prayer in this community? These opportunities grow us and give us great joy.

As we reflect this Easter season, why is Jesus' church still alive after 2,000 years? The church is here because He lovingly lives in us, not so that we live unto ourselves, but so that we shine with the Holy Spirit as His spiritual leaders, wooing people in the community to God, ministering to them, teaching them, witnessing to Christ's power in our lives, and praying for them, as we do for each other. FPCD does that beautifully, making the Lord—and me as your pastor—very proud.
