A vehicle pulled up across the street and we went to see if the driver would like some vegetables. He rolled down his window and was excited about the onions and garlic that he could use to make gumbo!

We went to another house and the lady who answered immediately invited us in. We sat on her sofa as she explained how she was house sitting for her friend who was in the hospital, and she asked us more about the bags so she could tell her friend where the great vegetables came from when she got back home. It was such a blessing to be able to sit with her, and keep her company for a few minutes while spreading Jesus' love. Before we left, Pastor Ginger asked if we could pray with her for her friend, and we huddled in a circle and bowed our heads together.
