# From your Session

Recently, Pastor Ginger referenced my son Tristan in her sermons illustrating the power of prayer and how we should never give up because things look impossible. You may now be familiar with his accident but may not be familiar with our experience when he was transferred to Our Children's House Dallas for inpatient therapy.


Tristan had been in ICU for 2 weeks and then in a regular hospital room for 2 days and was still in the process of coming out of a drug induced coma when he was transferred. It was late in the afternoon and we were being introduced to all of the therapists and doctors that would be working with Tristan. In the middle of that, a person came to the door saying they were with the animal therapy program and were about to leave but wanted to see if it was OK if they came in since we had recently arrived. We of course said yes and in walked a pony, which is amazing because Tristan loves ponies. They are his favorite. The pony, whose name was Spirit, came in and nudged Tristan's foot and nibbled on his sock. Of course Tristan was still nonresponsive at that time, but we all thought it was pretty awesome. Megan, who we learned would be his occupational therapist, said she had seen therapy dogs but never a therapy pony. Lucy took that as a sign that we were in the right place for him to get better.

Soon after that she had to go home to get clothes because only one parent could stay at a time and she was going to stay first. The other kids were staying at home with my sister, and when Lucy got there, she said she told the kids about the pony and Logan told her, "That's what I prayed for!" She asked him, "What do you mean?" He told her "I prayed that God would let Tristan see a pony in real life".

During the rest of his stay we always hoped to see the pony again, especially after Tristan came out of the coma completely and started talking and interacting with others. After Tristan was released from inpatient therapy he continued outpatient therapy for several years and was able to keep Megan as his occupational therapist (she still tells us Tristan was her favorite patient). Tristan was eventually released from outpatient therapy but continued to return every 6 months for Neuro Psych Appointments. Sometimes we were fortunate enough to see Megan who told us that there had never been another pony that came through as a therapy animal.

Sometimes in our moments, God allows a little ray of sunshine to remind us that things aren't always impossible.
