From your Session

God's Got Your Back

Do you have any pets? We recently added a kitten to our family. Her name is Duchess. She's four months old, playful, curious and simply adorable. It's so cute to see her play with her toys or stare at the turtle tank or even just take a nap in the living room chair where she looks extra small. She's brought so many smiles to our days. There's just one little thing - Duchess is a scaredy-cat. She scares so easily with just sudden noises or movements, and I wish she'd be more confident, but who am I to be so harsh on her? Sometimes I can be a big scaredy-cat ... sometimes I feel like the disciple saying, "Lord, save us! We're going to drown!" (Matthew 8:25) Sometimes I act like the disciple of little faith, afraid. I forget that "God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and selfdiscipline." (2Timothy 1:7). You know a really cool thing about that passage is Jesus calms the storm "he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm." And he does that in our storms today.

Jesus tells us that "if you had faith even as small as a mustard seed, you could say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it would move. Nothing would be impossible." (Matthew 17:20) One of the things we did as a session was attend a workshop conference where the focus was on the path to connect two realms:
Earth and Heaven. The visible with the invisible, our 5 senses with the Holy Spirit, Common Sense and the Bible, Reason and Faith. Paul Maconochie often referenced Hebrews 11, Faith in Action / Great Examples of Faith, and I think that most of us strive to be more as the warriors than the worriers.

So I encourage you to engage in more trust falls with God. Increase your offering and trust that God will provide what you need. Reach out to a member in your community whether that's a colleague, a neighbor or stranger - don't be afraid to connect with others. God has our backs; He tells us to not be afraid. He is with us and He strengthens us and He helps us and He holds us in his righteous right hand. (Isaiah 41:10)
