Enlarge My Territory

1 Chronicles 4:10 says, "Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me. And God granted him that which he requested." (KJV) The Bible also includes Jabez was more honorable than his brethren. We love the way this sounds and believe that God will magically and abundantly bless us, in an instant, with no temptations or trials. But, something has to be tested, before God can see you fit to handle more. If you are considered honorable, how honorable are you under pressure? Are you willing to pay the price to prove you are ready for increase in your life?

Increase comes with a price called obedience. I want to ask you this question, Can God trust you to be humble and patient when things are not going our way? Paul says, "All things (good and bad) work together for the good of them who love the Lord and are called according to His purpose." We find it's not the good things that happen to us that test our Christian character, but it's the bad things as well. It's not the arrogant Peters in life that test our character, but the backstabbing Judases. Do you have the capacity to love when love isn't coming your way?


As we go through life, we find that God gives us daily opportunities to love our enemies, pray for the ones who abuse us,

and to help those in need, even if they stole from us. 1 Corinthians 10:13 says, "There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it." (KJV)

Let's put this together. When we ask for increase, we are asking God to give us more opportunities to show Him obedience, by being humble, loving, and appreciative to God that He is using our everyday lives to win souls. God uses all trials and temptations to develop our Heavenly character. The exit God gives us from trials and temptation is obedience. Think about it, did Jesus have quick and easy exit from the cross, or did He go through it with God? What price are you truly ready to pay for God to give you increase in your finances, your marriage, your ministry, or your relationship with others? What are you willing to go through with God, to prove your obedience to Him?
