Samuel anointed the king (David) who began the ancestral line of Jesus, the King of kings. But it would be 1,000 years before Jesus arrived. Over the years, many prophets continued to proclaim him, even though they would never fully understand the message God gave them. In the same way, we don't fully understand all the prophecies which are future to us. Yet we wait expectantly. We recognize the life-changing opportunities in Jesus which have already been fulfilled, and even more so within those prophesies to come.

When our choir was asked to sing Handel's Messiah in New York City, they were being asked to proclaim the whole history of prophecies of God's plan of redemption through Jesus. In hearing Messiah from beginning to end, the overwhelming message is that God's plan was not an accident, but intentionally set, whether we are able to grasp it or not. On Sunday Brittany sang it, "There is a Redeemer, Jesus God's own Son . . . " and indeed there is! He is sent because God loves us. That is not a trite statement, but an entirely costly one.

This Christmas, think about how the fulfillment of those prophecies has affected your life. How does it feel to have Jesus to talk to? How does it matter to be able to turn to him?

What's it like to be guided by the light of Jesus? C. S. Lewis describes his entry into our world like this: He stooped down in order to lift, he must also disappear under the load before he is, incredibly, able to straighten and then he marches with the whole load swaying on his shoulders. Now does that remind you of a prophecy? "For a child is born to us, a son is given to us. The government will rest on his shoulders. And he will be called: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6).

May you live in the light of redemption, and at the same time, be a light to someone this season, sharing the ongoing prophecies of Christ Jesus. Merry Christmas!




