From your Admin Assistant

This Season of Lent has caused me to pause and think a lot about our need 'to be in constant relationship with God, being intentional about getting to know Him better and walking with Him, not just when it's convenient or we have a specific need we want Him to come through for, but every day, by reading His Word and through prayer. It has been neat working in the office getting to support various groups as they begin ministries that work towards this very thing – better relationship and connection with God.


In March I saw two new Bible studies begin, one a 6-week Lenten Study that meets Wednesday nights through April 17, and the other, a new monthly Bible Study for younger ladies and teen girls that meets every 3rd Monday of the month. I joined the new Ladies Bible Study and went to the first session on March 18. Our study group is using a book called Seamless that goes through the whole Bible and tells the seamless story of Scripture. This has further encouraged me to be in and to study the Word, and though the study does not require it, it inspired me to put together a Scripture reading plan that will take me through the whole Bible by the end of the study in November.

In the last few months our Session of elders began spearheading a Prayer Initiative for all of Duncanville to help our community learn about prayer, bringing them closer to each other and to God. Separately from the elders, the deacons began a new outreach in our parking lot, specifically to encourage the families who use the lot in the afternoons to pick up their children from school. As part of this ministry, they decided to hang a mailbox at one

of the visitor spots so anyone could drop by and drop off a prayer request and we could know how better to pray not just for our community as a whole but the individual needs within it. They purchased two boxes, one to hold pen and paper for writing the prayer requests, and the other to accept the requests. The boxes have been painted and will be put to use beginning this month!

As we begin to pray for and with our community, it is only fitting that we have another community-wide event coming up this month for Good Friday. In 2016, 10 churches joined together to put on TGIF: A Good Friday Event at Duncanville High School. This year, we are repeating the event, but with 9 churches at Centro Familiar Cristiano, and slightly different music. I am continually blessed to work at a church that puts community outreach and involvement so high on our priority list, because it's not just you and I who need to be in close relationship with God, but the community we live in needs to come to know Him and be in relationship with Him. Can you imagine what would happen if all of Duncanville knew Jesus and shared Jesus with everyone they knew?

Attendance in Sunday School at 9:15 is encouraged.


Donations of wrapped candy or small Easter prizes will be accepted through Palm Sunday, April 14.


These may be placed in the Narthex outside the Sanctuary or in the Church office.


The Agape Circle will meet on Wednesday afternoon, April 10th, at 1:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall of the church.
