#### From your Session "In Over My Head"

Recently Pastor Ginger preached a sermon with a similar title. I found myself thinking of times in my past when I've been in over my head. One in particular stands out in my memory as a pointer to Jesus' involvement in my life.

It was my third year in college, and I still did not know how to swim. Two earlier attempts at learning had been failures. Time for another try: physical education courses at my school included swimming. I signed up.

After a couple of sessions doing the usual beginning steps, I was not making progress. The teacher noticed this and said, "I want you to stretch out, lying on top of the water." I gave it a try. In a few seconds I was not only in over my head, I was in over my entire body, lying on the bottom of the pool! After I'd got my head back above water the teacher said to me, "Oh! I see – you're a sinker. You'll just have to work more."

The teacher's work reminds me of Jesus. Here are some parallels that I find helpful:

The teacher is interested in my problem(s) – and so is Jesus. The teacher knows me better than I know myself – and so does Jesus: a *lot* better! The teacher wants to help me – so does Jesus, and He will help me more than the human teacher The teacher has a plan for me – so does Jesus: it may be difficult but is what I need. Fast forward to the present. Lately I'm reminded that more than ever I need to look to the Teacher – Jesus – for every aspect of life. It seems that in earlier years His path for me was more often than not "beside still waters" (Ps. 23). Today the path involves "new normals" every so often. Energy is lower, and things get done more slowly. I'm inclined to feel a little like Paul the apostle must have felt as he listed his difficulties including being lashed, beaten, stoned, shipwrecked, adrift at sea, and facing danger (2 Cor 11:24-26).

But Jesus remains the same! He still wants to hear me pray. He still sends grace my way. He speaks as I read the Scriptures, worship, and receive encouragement from fellow believers. He sends me to give out cups of cold water in His name. He encourages me after bottom-of-the-pool experiences! He accepts my thanks.
