Get Real. As a teenager I found that God was really FOR me and not against me, and that being forgiven changed my heart. Unbelievable! God wants to be friend and companion and life source for Dennis. Get Going. To make a difference in a broader way, I have to try new things. A coworker once told me that the only way to enlarge my comfort zone was to get outside of it and pull! This is true for ministry outside my home culture, but it is also true in Duncanville. As a church and as individuals, it will do us good to get outside our comfort zone sometimes, to fail, or to need help, to be uncomfortable, in order to do what is needed.

May God lead us and let us be a blessing to our community in 2021!
