## Be a Blessing!

This month, as we move throughout our busy lives, let's remember if you take care of God's business, He will take care of yours. So, what actually is an interruption? Usually we think, I pray, God answers, problem solved. But what if an interruption comes your way and changes your whole day? Is that God answering your prayer?


Sarah Circle will meet on March 9, 2021 in the home of Diane Pegues at 7 pm.
