From our Pastor

I began preparing for writing this article by reading old newsletter articles from 2008 and on. When I think of the work we have done together, the thing that impressed me is that it continues to carry on. Enthusiasm for the Lord Jesus does not wane, even when circumstances go entirely against us, as has been the case for our 2020 national tragedy of the coronavirus. In fact, we continued to gather each week, living within the boundaries of restrictions until they were loosened, and continued to worship and explore how to go deeper in our walk as a disciple.

This year you all led the Lent Wednesday night Bible studies. Each week that night's leader drew out the participants' perspectives on the practice of our faith. We talked about walking with God through thick and thin by worshiping, praying, studying, serving, giving, and sharing. Your insights showed a great deal of maturity—you have grown since 2008! And so have I.

As we enter Holy Week, we walk with more confidence, more faith, more trust, and more thought that we need to be ready for what the Lord is bringing us. "Be ready" your elders say! It's our new catch phrase and you have picked it up.

A few years ago I wrote this about the spiritual gifts given to the church: "Some might expect the pastor to do all these things. But to think that these gifts are bundled into one person would be a tremendous misinterpretation of Scripture. Actually Peter tells us we are all considered priests who are holy and set apart for God. As God's own people, we are to become united, learn to walk by faith . . . speak the truth in love to others, and build others up in love. While we go about ministering for God, we become

mature ourselves. It's the process—the doing—that brings maturity."

The newsletter article continued: "Now if we think this ministry of outreach is ONLY for each other in the church we are badly mistaken. These gifts are meant to flow OUT of the church to the community around us. Thus we have a history of public ministry; public storytelling; public worship through music; public generosity to the poor; public prayer in public places like the schools, the city government, business organizations, altruistic organizations, and with friends and neighbors. . . . "

As we reflect this Easter season, a season when we are beginning to build back the church after a long season of hardship we might ponder, why is Jesus' church still alive after 2,000 years? Perhaps it is because we are committed to live not for ourselves, but for Christ Jesus who lives in us. And when we do, we become more ourselves, more alive and free than we ever imagined.




