From Your Session

In our last Session meeting, we had a guest speaker who shared with us the two most important commandments. We were all pretty familiar with them:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. The second is, Love your neighbor as yourself." (from Mark 12:30-31 CSB)

He indicated that the ability to "love" others was the most required challenge that we all face in our relationship with God. I at first thought that this seemed like a possible goal where even someone like me might have a reasonable chance at making some headway.

But over the days ahead I began to realize that just like The Ten Commandments I was going to have to depend on God's grace for my inability to love/like/not hate a lot of people. In a world where Satin has dominion and we are slaves to greed, lust, anger and doubt, it sometimes leaves little room for compassion, concern, sympathy and hope. I think the biggest mistake I originally took from this lesson was the fact that "I" was going to be forced to

change my self to accomplish this massive task. The next day seemed full of:

"Excuse me I was next",

"Did you see that guy cut me off", and

"I hope he/she chokes on a _____!!!"

My only hope was tomorrow I was going to be surrounded by more likeable/Godly people. But NO, it was worse.

Then it dawned on me that Jesus said "I am always with you." The surprise was that He never expects us to do anything on our own. Jesus expects us to tap into His "Love, grace and forgiveness" to be able to try to love wholeheartedly. God asks us to turn to Him for strength, especially when the task seems undoable to us. So ask yourself what does this command mean to you and then ask the Lord to show you how to love the way He commands you.
