### **Becoming Community**

God is at work in peoples' lives.

Lucky, a man in his twenties, was at my house installing windows last week. I was thinking: "This guy is a professional, experienced and competent in his work. I'll ask him about windows and learn some things." I did learn some things about windows, but there was a lot more.

Lucky talked to me about frustrations in his work and in his life. As a customer, this was not what I expected or hoped to hear. Really not very professional. "Maybe I should complain to the contractor," I thought. But I wanted to get on with the windows, and I also wanted better things for Lucky.

Our conversation was not very focused. We talked about windows and flooring, education and work, family, relationships, church, life with God, opportunities past and present. Some of it was plainly offensive to hear. But behind Lucky's words and tone were questions:

"I feel stuck. What can I do?"
"I'm a mess. Prove to me that I have some worth."

I think that God would say to Lucky: "Yes, you are a mess. Where do you want to go from here? I am present. I like you. What do you want me to do for you?"

Well, I hope Lucky went home feeling some of that from me. The windows turned out great. I did not complain to the contractor, and I left Lucky an open invitation to drop by and visit some more.

Our community is made up of people like Lucky and me. Both of us are competent, unsure, professional, and immature, all at the same time. And God is at work in our lives. We'll do better together than alone, and it is good for us to talk and listen with each other.


