From our Session

The Storm

When I think of the word storm, I think of rain, muddy shoes, wet clothes, and bad traffic. The rain comes and then the next day, it's sunny again, as if it never even rained. When victims of Hurricane Katrina hear the word storm, they probably flashback in their minds to flood waters, and missing family members. They may think of their homes, possessions, and animals that were lost. For them, that storm most likely changed their lives forever.

Some storms are predictable, and we have plenty of time to prepare. Other times, the storm may come unexpectedly without any preparation time, and we have to just "weather" our way through it.

In life, storms can hit at any time, in any area of our lives: in our finances, health, family life, or work. In my own life, I would say that I have had some unpredictable storms with my health. The storm began unexpectedly in 2008 and felt liked it never stopped raging. For the first time in a long time, I feel as if I have reached a calm in the storm. The most important thing is what I have learned on the latter part of this journey.

Miracles

I arrived at First Presbyterian in 2014 and had been on dialysis for just over six months. I was blessed to have a live donor, and surgery was scheduled for May 2015. Unfortunately, I had unexpected complications after the surgery and had a disgruntled summer recovery.

I just couldn't understand why God would bless me with a new kidney, and then allow so many complications to arise. Of the six years I have had my first kidney, five were filled with multiple hospitals stays. This sadly took a toll on that kidney.

But something happened along the journey. I realized that when I was on dialysis, I had prayed for God to bless me with a kidney and keep me healthy enough to avoid having to do dialysis again: and He had done that! It might not have looked the way I wanted, but God's plan never does. Even as my first kidney began to lose function, I remained healthy enough to avoid dialysis. Years later, God is still answering that prayer. There are many who wait years for just one kidney, and here I stand with two.

A song was shared to me that says: "I've got miracles on miracles,
A million little miracles......
One, two, three, four, I can't even count 'em all."

It's more than just the big miracles. He blesses me daily with more than my mind can even conceive. In the midst of your storm, can you see the miracles?


