Prayer

I recently got my old truck running again. (Actually, Jeff did.) But, I had an issue with the battery terminals, and thinking my quick fix for it was holding, I drove it to put some air in the tires. The problem with that is that my quick fix decided to stop working and was dead in front of the free air pump at Quic-Trip. Eventually, I was able to get it started, and as I started pulling onto the road, it died. As it rolled, I was able to restart it, and while I sat at the red light in neutral, feeling it hesitating and wanting to die again, I said a quick prayer: "Dear Lord Jesus, pleeeeease just keep it running till I get home. Just let me get it home." You know, the kind of quick prayer you might say before taking a test. Well, the light turned green, I put it in drive and head for home.

As I approach my house, I am relieved that there were no hesitations or stalls and that I will be at my driveway in a few seconds. I hadn't given the quick prayer I said a second thought until, as I turn into my driveway, the truck dies, and I coast to a stop at the bottom. I sat there for a moment after I stopped and thought, "Wow, that is exactly what I asked for. Nothing more. Nothing less." I said another prayer, thanking God for getting me home with the truck.

The Small Group I'm in just finished the book of John where Jesus, on several occasions, tells His disciples:

"...ask and you will receive..." John 16:24,


"Whatever you ask in my name, that I will do..." John 14:13, "...so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name, He will give it to you." John 15:16.

What problems in your life do you need God's power for? Lift them up in prayer and ask God to show you His goodness and greatness as your problems diminish.



Easter Egg Hunt Volunteers Needed!


