From our Pastor

Recently we asked you to make lots of cookies for our booth at the Flavor of Duncanville. This request was unusual, no doubt! But you did it! Your cookies—all homemade—made a splash. We gave away cookies to EVERYONE because when attendees and people who were there working booths heard that First Presbyterian had homemade cookies, they visited our booth.

You probably wondered why we needed cookies for this once-a-year citywide event, the purpose of which is to display what Duncanville people do best. Booths included local businesses, restaurants, the Duncanville city government, and small business entrepreneurs. Why did we even need to be there? How is Flavor of Duncanville a ministry?

Did you know that First Presbyterian was **the only church** represented there? Why are churches in Duncanville so hidden? Aren't we part of the "flavor" of Duncanville? So, we asked, what do the people of Duncanville need to think about the Church (at large) in Duncanville? Our answer:

At this booth, we wanted to make people feel good and send them away with something— expose them to ministries at FPCD and invite them to join us. We gave out FPCD brochures, pens, and cookies to make them smile! We wanted to interact with them where they are, and so we did a survey with these two questions:

What do you need from your local church? How can our church serve you best?

Here are some of the answers to the questions. People need:

Prayer, a safe place, a place to belong, to meet friends, fellowship, support, healing of America's divisions, acceptance, a place to serve, group worship, a place for meditation and focus on connection with God; peace, outreach programs, an understanding pastor, phone calls and visits with seniors and bereaved; to help find your unique outreach ministry for your community. A safe place for children and a safe place to be friends.

There were more comments than these but space prevents me from listing them all!
One restaurant owner told me "Come by!" I said, "Yes, I need to eat at your restaurant more!" He replied, "No, not that. Just check on us. See how we are doing." How wonderful that a business owner wants people from a church (including their pastor!) to check on his employees.

What is your vision of ministry? To whom are we to minister? Yes, those less fortunate. And to those who are ill, have experienced a tragedy, or are having a temporary crisis. But there are so many opportunities for us to minister to everyday people going about life, when we are in the stream of the things happening on our streets; when we get out of the doors of the church.

Written on our bulletin, website, and all our brochures is our mission:


Connecting with God and sharing the good news of Jesus Christ with the community




