EASTER SUNDAY SCHOOL – Join us for Sunday School for all ages on Easter Sunday at 9:15 AM in the Education Building.


EASTER EGG HUNT – Children are invited to join us for an Easter Egg Hunt at 10 AM, at the end of the Sunday School hour.
