Constant Change

It may seem a bit awkward to place these two contrasting words together. Each word is the exact opposite of the other. I want to share what both of these words have meant to me over the last few years.

Life Changes

For me, I would say that big life changes began happening at the start of college. I was excited to live away from home. I had no idea that I would be dealing with health challenges the following year. As I tried balance staying on top of classes, taking my medication, playing and directing at church, and preparing for my senior recital, I was drowning in a sea of changes.


How many of us feel from day to day that we have too many irons in the fire? Before we can even get settled and feel completion in one area.... something changes. It can be very uncomfortable trying to manage changes, especially when the future that follows is simply unknown. The most difficult changes often catch us by complete surprise. The loss of a loved one, losing a job, losing financial security, losing your health: these losses can really cause our hope and faith to dwindle. In dealing with these losses, I have learned to be grateful for the positive constants in my life.

Life Constants

I immediately began to think of the positive intangible constants like love, support, and friendship. I know that I would not have survived the last decade without the help and major support I have received from my husband, parents, friends, family, and church family. They all have unselfishly showered me with love, prayer, sacrifice, and support. All of the check-in calls, texts, hugs, and emails

over the years are uncountable. Above all, I believe that prayer (mine and others) has been vital to me processing and working through my personal life changes. I have heard many say that prayer changes things! I can testify to this: God will change the situation or your mindset and outlook about the situation.

Change, as unpredictable as it may be, will always remain constant. Life and its quirks are guaranteed to shift as the days and weeks turn into years. But there is another constant that gives me hope: our Heavenly Father. In the midst of all changes, He is ever-present and remains all-powerful. He sees and knows all and will never allow any change to transpire that we cannot bear. Even in the midst of the chaos and the moments that seem unbearable, God knows, cares, and will carry us through.

PARKING LOT MINISTRY (PLM)

FPCD has had a community focus for many years. As we observed how parents use our church parking lot during the school year to pick up their children from Reed Middle School, we saw we had not only an opportunity – but a call from God – to reach out to them with love and encouragement. Thus, the Deacons (now Member Care Team) began the Parking Lot Ministry in February 2019. The goal – that in the handing out of a little gift, being willing to interact as appropriate, offering a smile, word of encouragement, listening ear, and giving them a chance to submit prayer requests – we might put some hope and joy in their day. We want them to know that GOD is LOVE and that HE CARES about them, their families and the multitude of challenges and distresses in their lives.

Each month we prepare 40 small gifts, usually with a Scripture coordinating with the gift, and a treat/snack for each vehicle as well as a prayer request form – about 32 in English and 8 in Spanish. We point out that prayer requests can be submitted at any time and can be put in the PRAYER MAILBOX on the post near the playground equipment. Jennifer McWilliams painted the PRAYER MAIL and SUPPLIES boxes and Dub Guthrie put them up. Vanessa Cordova, Leo Skinner and Paul Griffith have helped with Spanish translations.

So once a month, we are looking for 3-4 volunteers to help with this outreach from 4:00 – 4:45pm on a Thursday afternoon (occasionally a Tuesday or Wednesday when weather is an issue). There is a signup sheet in the narthex. Please consider helping with this effort. It doesn't take much time - 45 minutes once a month! God blesses far more than He asks!
