#### From our Pastor

Dear Friends at FPCD,

This is the earliest Christmas newsletter article I could find that I wrote to you after becoming your pastor. I admit—my message has not changed at all. My goal has always been to draw you as near as possible to the Lord Jesus Christ. I hope this is the legacy I leave with you, that you know him well. I pray that you continue to grow in your faith and relish in this wonderful season:

Why God? Often you hear that question. It might be "Why, God?" as if asking why did this adverse circumstance happen. Or, it might be "Why God?" as in why should I think about the need for God? The season of Advent poses this question to us and as we ponder its answer, hopefully you and I can respond with a well-reasoned argument of 'here's why I believe God is valuable and vital to the good life.'

Advent, means coming, arrival, official visit. In ancient Greek culture the visitation of a ruler meant preparing flattering speeches, improving the streets, hanging golden wreaths, giving money, making things magnificent.
