Dear Friends, March 7, 2023

Several weeks ago, our partners in the Caribbean celebrated the dedication of the recent translations of several Old Testament books in three Caribbean languages; Jamaican, Belize Creole, and San Andres Creole. We were unable to attend the celebrations in Kingston since we were finishing a workshop with partners in Nigeria online. However, we got to watch the celebration live through their YouTube connection. Only recently have some groups made a strong effort to write some of these Caribbean creole languages whole others from the community disregard the written Creole preferring instead to read English or Spanish. Nearly everyone agrees that they prefer to speak in their creole when discussing weighty matters and connecting with close family and friends. For this reason, the partners in the Caribbean decided to conduct an oral Bible storytelling project in parallel with the written OT translation project. Jim and I are helping to train the storytelling teams in Jamaica, Belize, and San Andres.
