#### God's Will vs. My Will

Through the up and downs of life, I have learned that it's easy to get caught up in the pursuit of what I think will bring me happiness. As a kid, I couldn't wait to get out of the house and not live with my parents. At no point was I thinking about how I would provide, financially speaking, for myself or how much work that would take. And I definitely was not praying and asking God to show me what to do. My first thoughts of career was forensics science. Well, that changed when senior year physics class hit. I couldn't understand why it took and entire page to do one problem.

I dropped the forensics idea but didn't have a solid replacement. I thought to myself, I could do music. But I had skipped out on doing private piano lessons my senior year because my schedule was just so busy....it was my choir teacher that got an audition set up for me at Baylor. I never DREAMED I could get in. But even above that, I received academic and music scholarships. God's plan still happened just not in the way I could have imagined.

Years later, I think back and laugh at how I thought I had it all figured out. Even now, I worship and work at places I myself did not choose, but were led to by the will of God. Where I have "landed" was God's will all along.

I am learning the following major life lessons.

1. To be content. If it has to be pushed into place then it is probably not in the plan. I have spent much of my adult life in a continual cycle of stress. Life after COVID has been much less stressful. I am learning to be content with my life and be aware of the precautions I have to take to be healthy and take care if myself. This means

I can't spend every waking moment always chasing more.

- **2. To be appreciative**. I am learning to value where I am in life and what God has given me. It may not be all I want, but it is surely all I need!
- **3. To trust God's plan**. In all the commotion of the last decade; the family, health, and career roller coaster, God has still been faithful. He has shown me that in all seasons, he will work things out in His

timing. There is comfort in knowing that.

This poem titled "His Plan for Me" by Martha Snell Nicholson sums it all up for me.

When I stand at the Judgment Seat of Christ And He shows me His plan for me, The plan of my life as it might have been, Had He had His way; and I see

Of the years that remain in my life, my prayer is that God will reveal his plan for my life and help me to be patient when I feel like things are stagnant. I hope that my life and testimony can bring Him glory. God's will definitely triumphs over mine.
