From your Session

We are now into the second half of 2025. I thought I would discuss the financial status of the church. For the last few months our expenditures have exceeded the money from offerings. We have money saved from previous generous donations, so we have been able to stay in the black overall. We do not need to panic, but it is time to seek ways to change the situation.

What is the cause of this?

Costs have increased. Property insurance has had a steep increase in the last few years. Utility (electric, gas, water) prices have increased. Almost everything we buy has had a price increase. The number of giving units has decreased. We have had several members that have gone on to their rewards. We have some that can no longer attend because of their health. Many of our members are living on a fixed income. No matter how much additional they wish to donate, it is not possible.

What have we done about it?

We haven't replaced Katherine. The Hispanic church is cleaning the church so we no longer need a cleaning service. Darrell Ingram has volunteered to take over the bookkeeping. We will no longer have to pay someone to do it for us. We do not make any purchases if they can be delayed. Pastor Rachael has talked to a pastor of a large church about our situation. He then gave her some possible actions to increase income. This was at no cost to us.

What can the congregation do?

The first is to pray about the situation. Pray that God would give Pastor Rachael and the session guidance to find ways to increase income while providing service to the community. Pray for an increase in donations. Pray for new members to share the load.

If you can increase your giving, please do so. I know for some of you on a fixed income that is not possible. Maybe you can donate time to help get the work done more easily. Maybe you have some ideas you can share that can help. We are always open to suggestions.

Our Church

Our church is vital to the community. Pastor Rachael is active in the ministers' group. The Member Care Team coordinates the monthly Parking Lot Ministry in reaching out to bless and encourage the parents picking up their students from Reed Middle School. We take part in the Flavor of Duncanville and have a float in the July 4 parade. We offer water and hotdogs for those who watch July 4 fireworks from our parking lot. We provide sandwiches each month to the Austin Street Shelter. We provide some support to several missionaries with whom we have a relationship. We are important. With prayer and some new projects, we should be able get through this rough patch.
