Jeremiah 29:11: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future".

When we moved to the United States ten years ago, one of the biggest challenges for me was finding a church where I could truly worship God. I visited several churches, but I didn't feel any desire to become a member. During that time, I kept praying and asking God to guide me to a church that would feel like home.

The verse from Jeremiah 29:11 beautifully defines the beginning of this chapter in our lives. I was simply searching for a church but after five years, God gave me so much more. He led me to a place not only to worship, but to be surrounded by people who show compassion, love, and care. I am truly grateful to be part of FPCD and continue to pray that more people will be led to this church, according to God's will.
